PHILOSOPHY / VISION

The Team Canada National Team program is both; an elite athlete program which elevates Canada to the highest levels of International Achievement; and a program which develops Ambassadors representing Cheerleading in Canada. With the addition of our Long-Term athlete development program (the Academy), Cheer Canada is putting into action a program to help "the next generation" of high performers - providing them with professional expertise and on-going coaching.

Academy coaches are responsible for executing a world-class training plan built in conjunction with the National team coaches. The Academy coach expertise will be invaluable in creating nation-wide technique improvements; as well as, increased preparation of athletes entering the Premier team divisions in future years.

We envision three groups of coaches assisting with The Academy. 1. Former TC Elite and Premier Coaches who no longer coach at the National-team level 2.
