



# **SPECIALTY DIVISIONS 2019/2020**

## **DIVISIONS**

**Specialty divisions include: individuals, duos, trios, partner stunt and group stunt.**

**The Provincial Sport Organizations (PSOs ) are able to choose what specialty divisions they offer to best accommodate their market, but the divisions must align with the existing divisions outlined in the Cheer Canada age grid. Please check with your PSO, or event producer to determine what specialty divisions are offered in your province, or the province where you will be competing.**

***Note: Non-tumbling and global divisions are not offered as specialty divisions.***

## **TIME LIMIT**

**For the 2019/2020 season, each PSO will decide the time limit for specialty divisions in their respective province, up to a maximum of 1 minute and 30 seconds. Please consult with your PSO, or event producer to determine the time limit in your province, or the province where you will be competing.**

***Starting in the 2020/2021 season, the time limit for all specialty divisions will be one minute.***

## **SCORE SHEETS**

**Specialty divisions compete on their own score sheets that are modeled after the international comparative scoring system. There is one score sheet for individuals/duos/trios and one score sheet for partner stunt/group stunt. These score sheets can be found on the Cheer Canada website.**

**Specialty divisions follow the international deduction system.**
